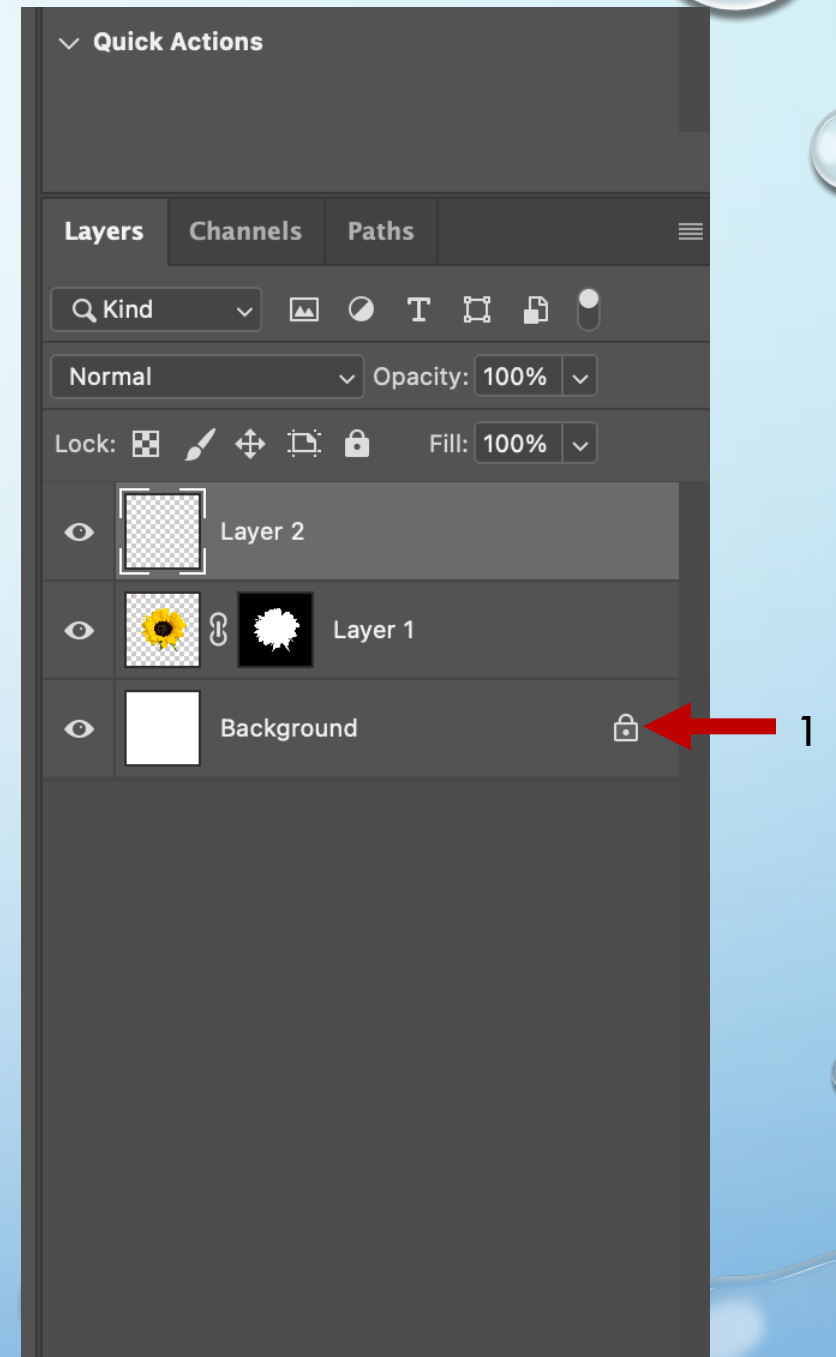

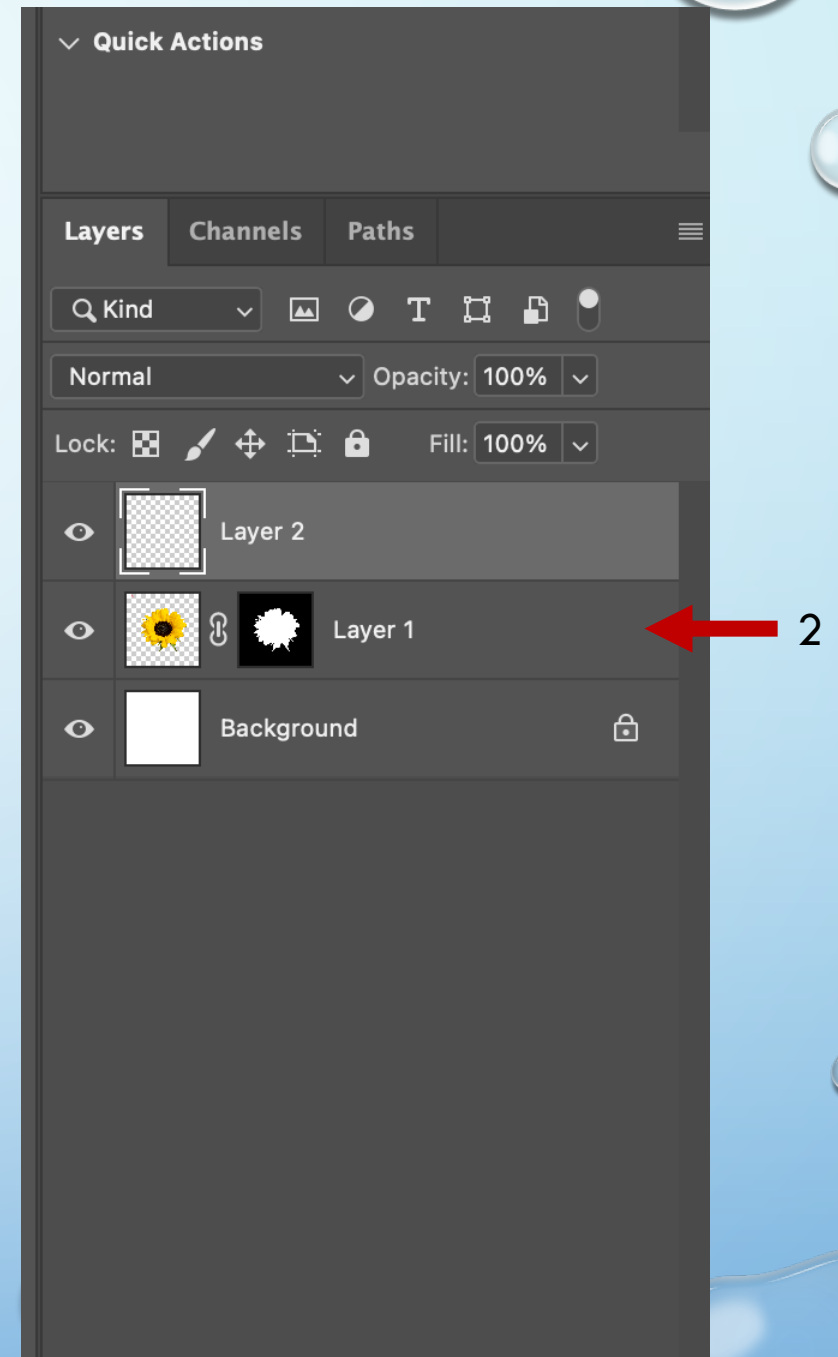
HOW TO START

2. INSERT YOUR **SUBJECT** PHOTO

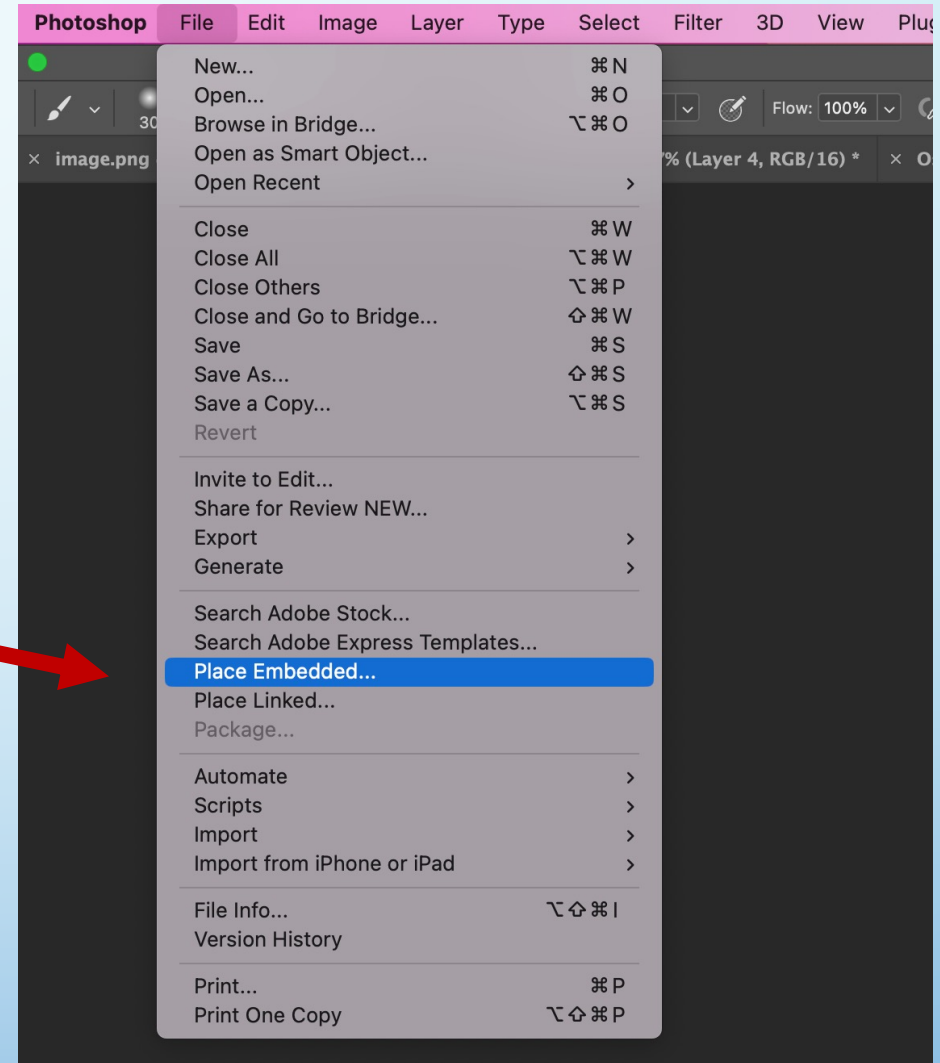


THE SUBJECT

4. Find **Subject** in you Files



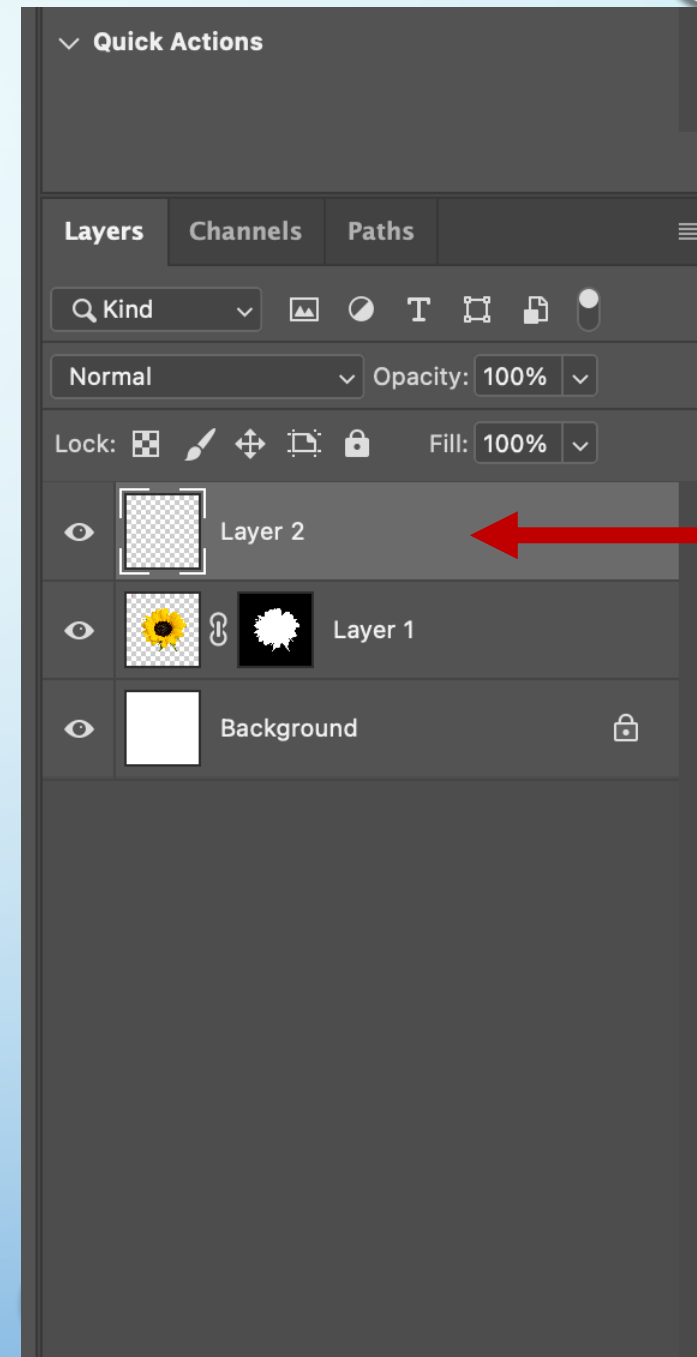

NEW LAYER

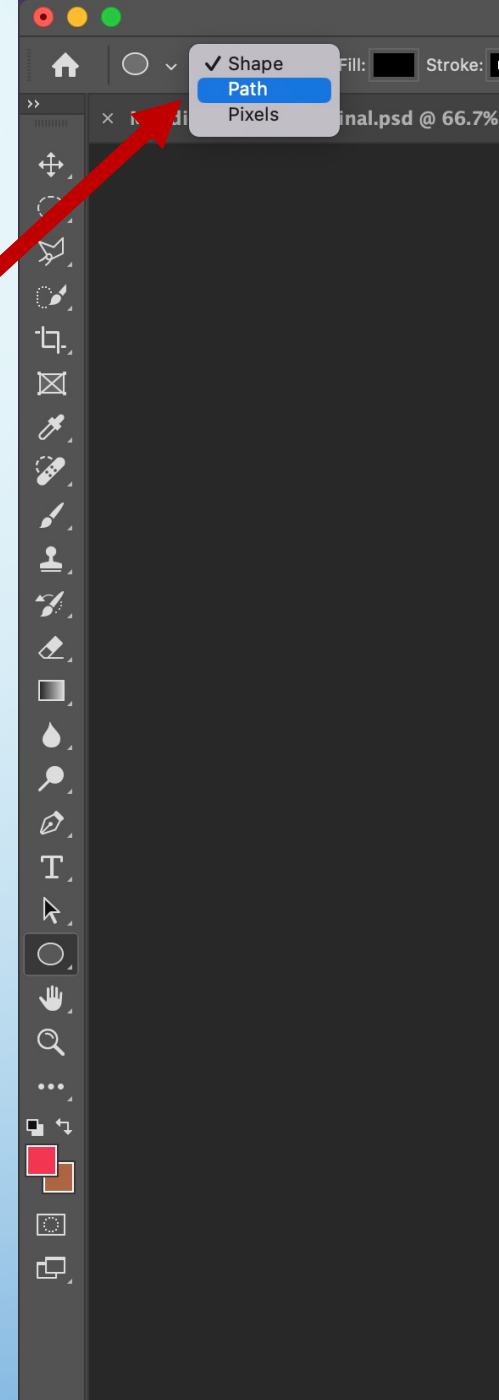
5. INSERT NEW LAYER

Note: This is the layer you put the flame on.

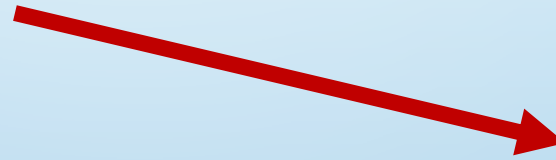


CREATING A CIRCLE

Ellipse Circle



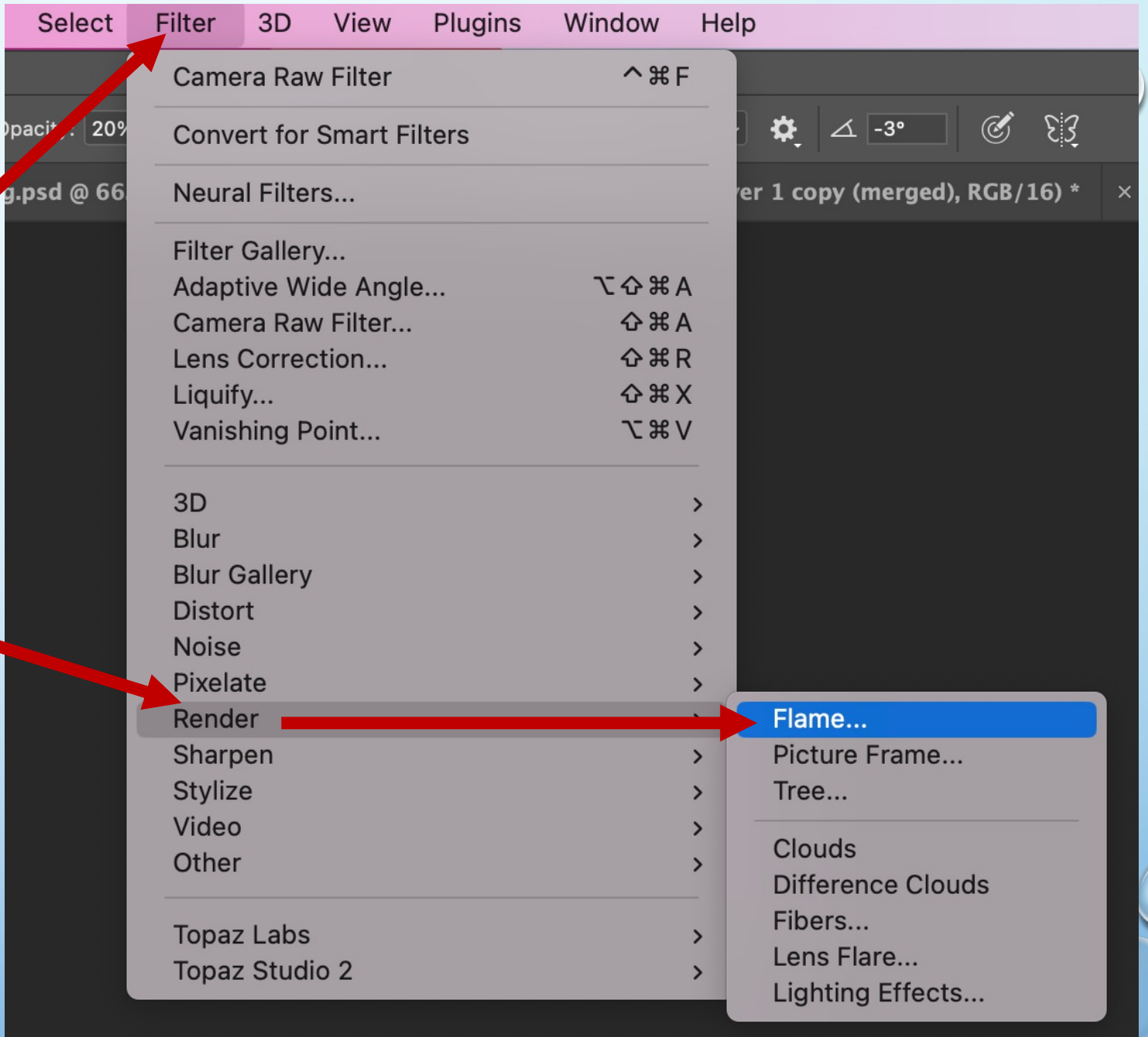

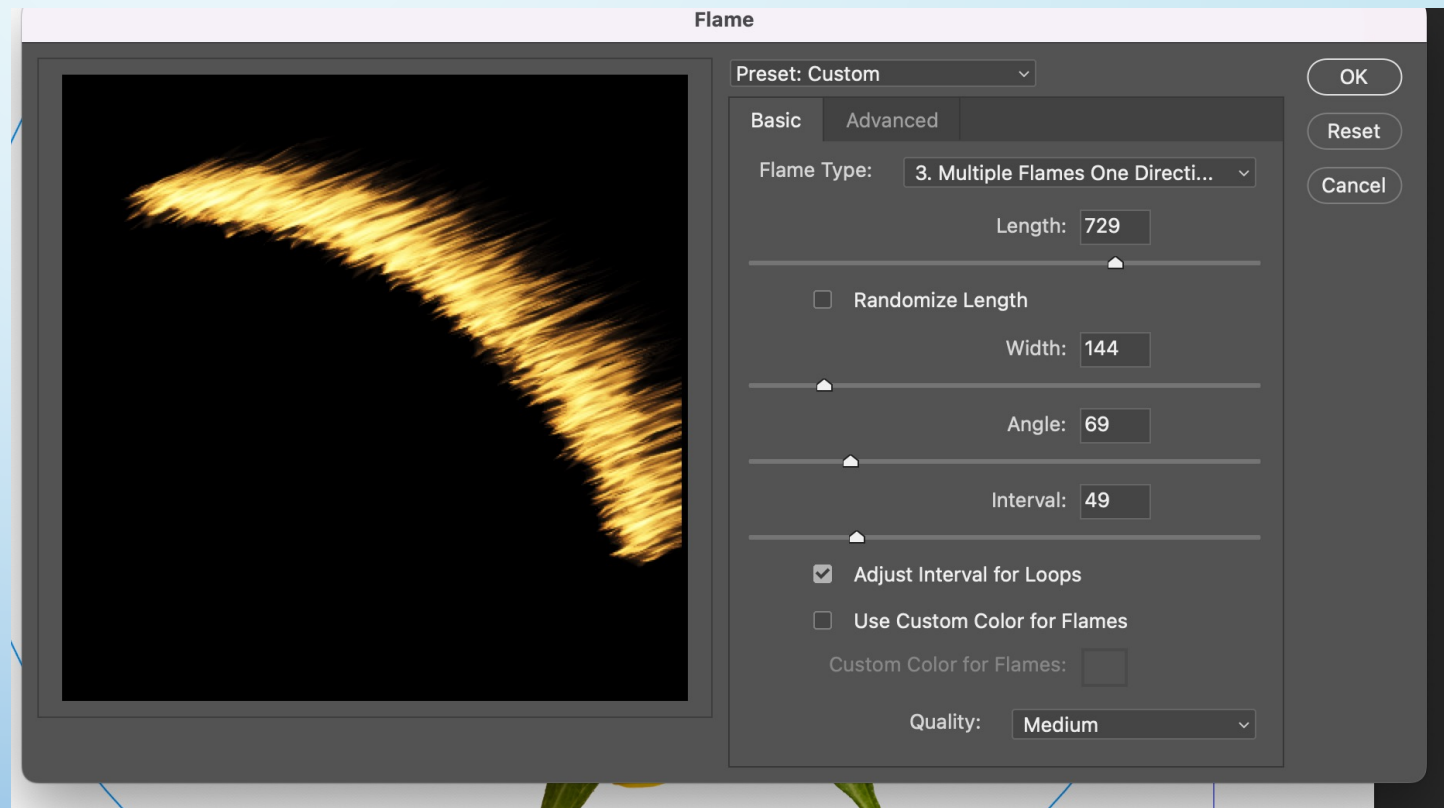
9. RENDER

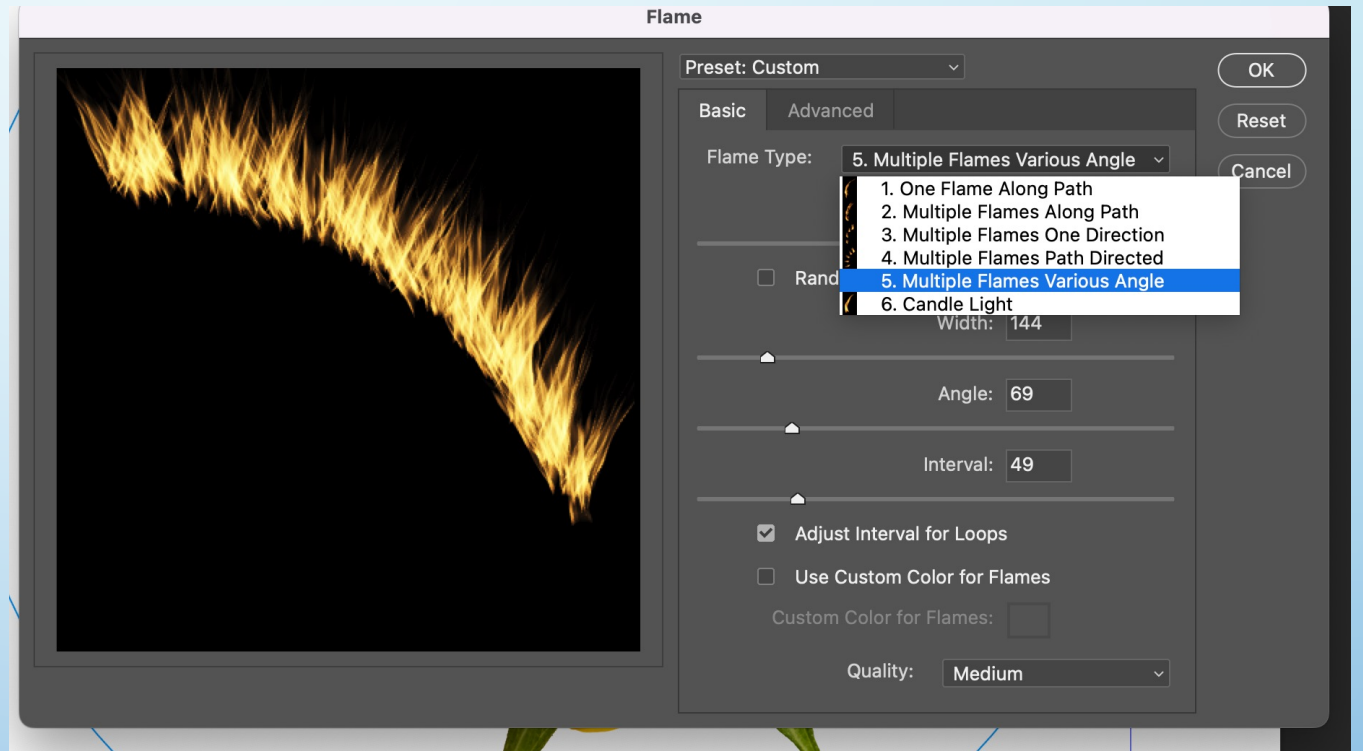


THE FLAME WINDOW
